His tea work includes a wide selection of workshops, conferences, field consulting, trade development and seminars all over the planet. He also runs 2 tea schools and various educational programs. His writing has been published in many languages and he co-authored of the prize-winning book TEA, History, Terroir, Varieties voted World's Best Tea Book 2014 by the World Tea Awards and now available in 5 languages.
